Are You Thinking of Adopting a Cat? By Jayn Corral

Have you been thinking about adopting a cat? Please consider visiting the S.P.A. to meet all the wonderful cats and kittens available for adoption. Do yourself a favor and adopt a cat or kitten that you know has had all the proper tests and care. Free kittens are never free. To quote a popular TV personality, "What is cheap, is expensive."

All of the S.P.A. cats and kittens are treated, tested, vaccinated (including for leukemia), and sterilized at the appropriate age in our clinic by our on-site veterinarian, Dr. Omar Córdova. All of

this is included in the \$500-peso adoption fee. Quite a bargain when you consider that actual costs for the same services can run up to \$3000 pesos or more.

Upon meeting your potential adoptee, you can quickly assess his personality. The volunteers will be happy to help you find the perfect cat for you and your situation. For example, they know if the cat is independent (like Chrissie and Larissa) or prefers to have another cat for companionship (like Chili and Nadia); and other personality traits.


Because territory is very important to cats, you will need to be patient when you first take him home. We recommend giving him a small, safe spot (such as a bathroom) with food, water, toys, social interaction, comfortable bed, and litter box. Cats instinctively scratch to groom their claws and to mark their territory so you will also want

to provide a scratching post to prevent them from inappropriately clawing your furniture.

Gradually introduce the new one to the family and to the rest of the house. Do not allow the new cat to go outside for at least a week to ten days to give your cat time to understand that this new environment is his home.

Cats are carnivores and cannot survive on a vegetarian diet. They are also lactose intolerant so should not be given dairy products designed for humans. It is best to provide real cat food. Changing their diet should be done gradually by introducing the new food and reducing the old food. A drastic switch in diet can cause diarrhea.

Adopting older dogs has many advantages. Older dogs are calmer than youngsters and need less exercise. Their personalities are developed and they're fully grown so there are few surprises. They are eager to learn new tricks and are less demanding of attention. They are particularly appropriate choices for an older person to adopt who would love to experience the joy of pet ownership, but probably doesn't have the energy level for a younger animal. Older adopted pets seem to understand what you have done for them by taking them into your family and they return your kindness

with uncommon love and

devotion.
