The S.P.A.'s annual Pet Food Money Bank fundraiser is our only major fundraiser of the year. We know that times are difficult, but we hope that you make a monetary donation to apply to the annual cost of feeding our resident animals like Mango and Ginger.

The S.P.A., San Miguel's only no-kill shelter for dogs and cats, houses a combined average of 100 animals and often has more in foster homes. We provide shelter, care (vaccinations, sterilization, medical care), and food for all of them until they become family companions—no matter how long it takes. Last year, almost 100 cats and dogs were adopted from us. We are proud of our adoption successes, knowing that we are helping to reduce the stray and homeless animal population in San Miguel de Allende.

As our cats and dogs become a part of families, we take in more animals. Some are so malnourished when they arrive that we must give them special supplemental food until they become stronger. Many of our animals, dogs in particular, have been at the S.P.A. for a long time (years). As they age, they require special food. Even some of our younger animals are sometimes on a unique diet. For these reasons, we have had to switch some of our residents from our regular, economy-priced food to other options. Because animals do not adjust well to changes in diet and we lack sufficient storage space, we need to raise money to cover the annual cost of feeding our cats and dogs, rather than seek donations of food.

The goal of this year's Pet Food Money Bank is \$250,000 pesos (about \$13,500 USD), 100% of which will be applied to the annual cost of feeding our family-pets-to-be. Please help us with this basic expense by making a monetary deposit to our Pet Food Money Bank. We rely solely on financial donations to survive and receive no government support. We economize, but need help from our supporters.

## Dulce and Tessie

Dulce and Tessie have a number of things in common. Each is a very beautiful dog. Medium-sized Tessie, a Golden Retriever mix, has sparkling eyes. Medium/large-sized Dulce is a snow-white Lab mix. Each lovingly soaks up affection and readily gives it back to those she knows. Both would be best as the only dog in the home, for different reasons. Each has been an S.P.A. resident since 2013.

Dulce is a great dog! She is very smart and knows how to sit, stay (wait), come, shake (alternating paws on command) and more. She is very loyal, devoted, and protective. When I take her in the back exercise area, she sunbathes, but keeps checking on me, making sure she knows where I am and that I'm okay. She routinely gets up, comes over for a little attention, and then goes back to stretching out in the sun. She's prone to jealousy when another dog is around.

Tessie is lovely. She always sticks her nose out of her casita door when I bring her back from a walk, signaling that she wants some more attention, a little extra, special treatment. I step inside with her and massage her head as she presses her body close to mine. She likes to go on abbreviated walks, more like sniffing excursions than exercise. She often snarls at other dogs for no rhyme or reason, despite my warning to her that the snarling detracts from her extremely good looks.

All in all, both sound delightful, right? So why have they lingered at the S.P.A.? The simple answer is because it is difficult for potential adopters to meet them. Neither one does well with strangers, but each in a different manner. Dulce can be immediately unfriendly to people she doesn't know, but it's not clear which ones will be acceptable to her. In a home, it is unlikely that she will greet visitors by turning over for a belly rub. Tessie is slyer than that. Sometimes she snaps at someone when she is caught off guard. It could be someone who is trying to pet her without any advance warning. Simply reaching over her head could cause her to snap at the person. Thus, with both dogs, it is important to be cautious – to earn their trust and love. You have to be willing to invest in the time it takes for them to get to know you and you to know them. You have to be a smart owner if you decide that Dulce or Tessie is the right one for you.

## Comforter, Healer, or Both

While I have had animals most of my life, I don't recall ever having had a traumatic injury as a pet owner. That changed a few weeks ago. But this story begins back in June.

Like others during this Covid pandemic, to ease our sense of isolation, my husband and I adopted a cat from the S.P.A. named Eros. He was 1-1/2 years old and indeed a charmer, so we kept his name. It fit. Over the last nine months, my husband and I fell head over heels in love with this guy. He has different vocals for different demands. He spoiled us with morning lap sits and enchanted us with his ever-widening exploration of our world. He became the trusted soldier monitoring our perimeter wall, sitting guard all night to ensure we did not come under attack from other furry nighttime prowlers. As all cat owners know, he became master and we, his humble servants, attending to his every whim.

Then I injured myself. The injury was traumatic resulting in seven hours spent in two emergency rooms to stabilize the wound. Surgery was scheduled for the following week. I was understandably in shock, physically and mentally exhausted. I came home and lay down to rest. Suddenly, Eros jumped on my stomach, lay down with his head on my chest next to my splinted arm, and purred. I dozed off and he stayed with me for an hour or more. For two weeks, both before and after the surgery, this behavior continued. The minute I lay down on the sofa or in bed at night, there came Eros to lie with me. I regularly nodded off to sleep feeling comforted by him.

Such a change in dynamics. Instead of us spoiling Eros, he was now taking care of me. After the first post-op review indicated it had been a successful surgery and I was out of danger, Eros's visits became more infrequent. But now I know. Not only is he a love, he is a comforter, and if the scientific literature is to be believed, his purring may actually have assisted me in healing more quickly. I am certain that the comparative ease in which I came through this traumatic event owes a great deal to Eros's comforting, healing touch.

The S.P.A. has other magical cats who will provide comfort to you in a myriad of ways. Hopefully, an emergency like mine won't be when you need to be soothed – just the ups and downs of everyday life, especially during these difficult times. 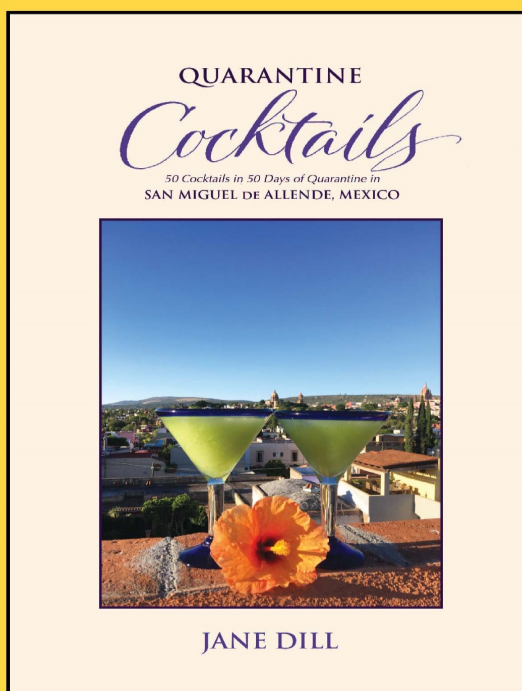

The items below are supplies we replace on a regular basis. Please drop off donations at the S.P.A. during our regular office hours.

- Batteries (AA)
- Brooms
- Cat baskets for kittens/cats to sleep in

- Cat food—Royal Canin Development for cats (soft & dry)
- Cat food—Royal Canin Gastrointestinal for cats (soft & dry)
- Cat food—Royal Canin Babycat Milk (dry powdered milk for kittens)
- Cat food platters (plastic, divided, circular trays)
- Cat litter (we use Petco bulk litter)
- Cat /kitten toys

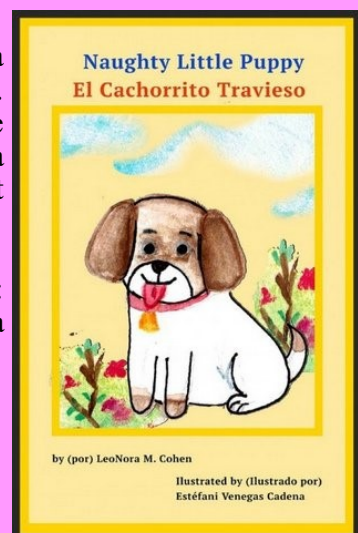
